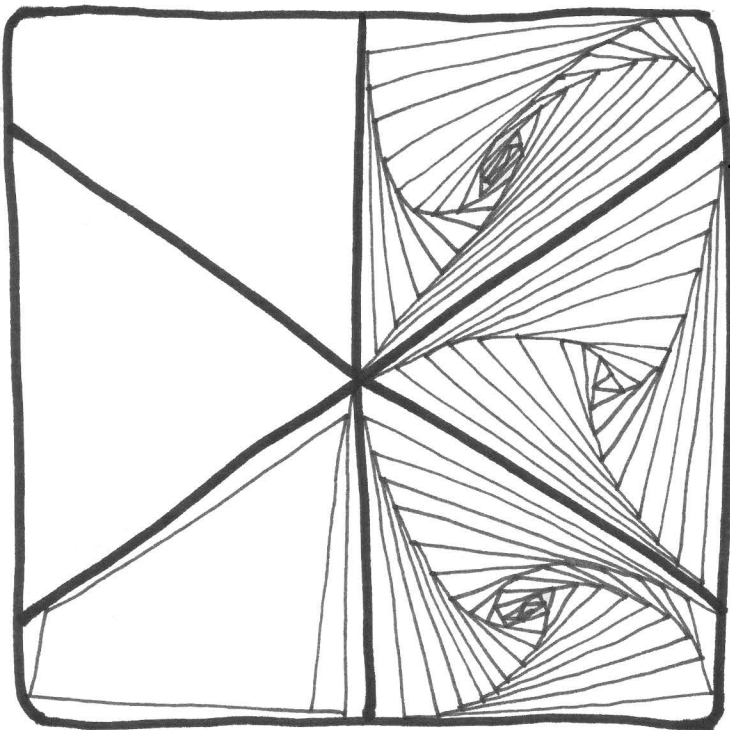

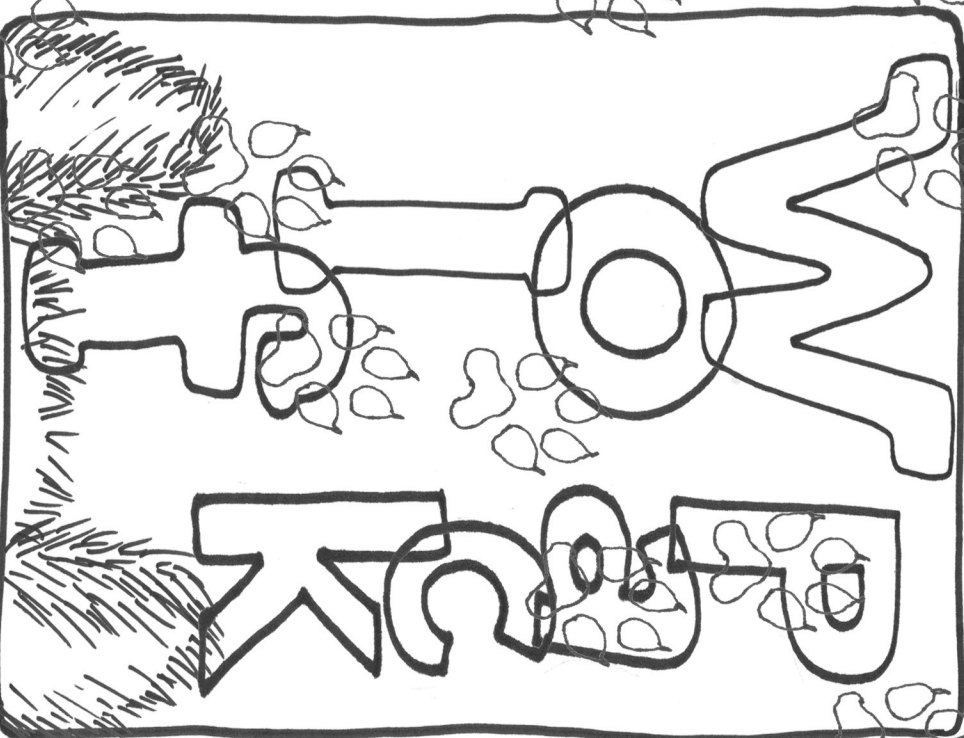

Create your own art with one of the choices.

<p><u>Primary Colors</u></p> <p>Red</p> <p>Yellow</p> <p>Blue</p> <p>first colors, primary, no mixing</p>	<p><u>Warm Colors</u></p> <p>Half the color wheel, all the reds, oranges and yellows including all the colors inbetween</p>	<p><u>Tint</u></p> <p>Add white into any color in various amounts to lighten, changing the value</p> <p><u>GM3</u></p>
<p><u>Secondary Colors</u></p> <p>Orange</p> <p>Green</p> <p>Violet</p> <p>mixing two primaries together</p>	<p><u>Cool Colors</u></p> <p>Half the color wheel, green, blue, violet and all the colors mixed with these colors</p>	<p><u>Shade</u></p> <p>Add black to any color in various amounts to darken, changing the value</p> <p><u>GM3</u></p>
<p><u>Tertiary Colors</u></p> <p>RO RV BV BG YG YO</p> <p>Tertiary colors are colors mixed with a Primary and Secondary color</p>	<p><u>Analogous Colors</u></p> <p>Colors next to each other on the color wheel (pick three colors)</p>	<p><u>Monochromatic</u></p> <p>Choose only one color using tints and shades giving different values of one color</p>
